1.1 Scope

To minimise impacts from past, future and current waste generation by implementing waste infrastructure and services that recognise the needs of the community now and in the future, are environmentally and economically responsible and reduce the amount of waste being disposed of to landfill.

- Working towards progressive reductions in the volume of waste being disposed of to landfill
- Reducing the potential impact from the previous generation of waste through the rehabilitation and management of closed landfills
- Controlling and reducing the potential impact from current waste generation through continuous improvement of waste activities and facilities, and developing local economic opportunities in the waste management sector
- Reducing the impact from future waste generation through waste minimisation, strategic planning of waste management assets and services, and community engagement programmes.
