





Explore world-class mountain bike trails with our two major networks in Eden and Tathra, providing more than a combined 100km of premium trails catering to all skill levels.




TOWNS AND VILLAGES

KEY VENUES AND FACILITIES

Our region is home to a number of venues and natural sites suitable for both indoor and outdoor events. Whether it's a beautiful lakeside natural amphitheatre, our wide open spaces or well-appointed recreation grounds, tree-lined golf courses or a modern boutique theatre, our region has an array of venues ready to host your event.



FOUR WINDS

Four Winds is an extraordinary music destination located just 9 minutes south of Bermagui at stunning Barragga Bay. Four Winds specialises in exceptional music experiences surrounded by nature, often blending classical form with First Nations voices, young emerging musicians and powerful multi-disciplinary storytelling. The purpose-built site is home to the 180-seat 'Windsong Pavilion', an acoustically pristine building custom designed for the finest listening experience. Alongside the Pavilion is the Sound Shell, a 2,000-seat outdoor amphitheatre used for larger-scale festivals and events.



BEGA VALLEY COMMEMORATIVE CIVIC CENTRE

Located in the heart of Bega, the Civic Centre offers entertainment and conference facilities with an auditorium that regularly plays host to community theatre, live comedy, music performances, conferences, large community gatherings and industry meetings. A beautiful, modern and well-appointed facility, the foyer and meeting rooms have views out to the surrounding hinterland and famous rolling hills of the Bega Valley.

THE TWYFORD THEATRE AND HALL

The Twyford has been at the heart of Merimbula and the wider region's arts and cultural landscape since it was first opened in 1931. The venue includes two key performing spaces. The heritage-listed hall has capacity to seat up to 170 with flexible seating and tables, whilst the newly completed theatre has capacity for 199 in raked seating.

Together with the adjacent supper room and commercial kitchen, the Hall is ideal for exhibitions, dances, smaller music performances, tabled and seated functions, rehearsals, play readings and larger meetings.

Opened in 2024, the new Theatre is a state-of-the-art facility with a licensed foyer cafe/bar and two dressing rooms, with unisex bathrooms and laundry facilities for up to 16 artists. All spaces except the upper dressing room are accessible. It is an ideal venue for theatre, dance, film screenings and larger music performances as well as small conferences.

Managed by a community-driven, not-for-profit company, The Twyford is able to provide ticketing, marketing and technical services for your event and can arrange function catering from local suppliers.

PAMBULA BEACH SPORTING COMPLEX

Located a short drive from the idyllic countryside village of Pambula, the Pambula Beach Sports Complex is one of the region's standout facilities. Capable of hosting up to 8,000 people on-site at any one time, each year it plays host to major events such as the much-loved Pambula Show, Pambula Motorfest and Wanderer Festival, a multigenerational music festival headlined by major international acts.

Set against the backdrop of gum trees, and only two kilometres from the mouth of the stunning Pambula River, this venue provides amenities expected by modern-day event goers nestled in amongst the natural beauty our region is famous for. CLUB SAPPHIRE

Located centrally in Merimbula, Club Sapphire is the premium venue for entertainment, workshops, events and conferencing.

The Auditorium (Audi) hosts a diverse range of activities, from large music performances, live comedy, community functions, conferences, weddings, and large gatherings. The Tasman Room and Sapphire Room offer stylish spaces for conferences, meetings, and private functions. Pacific Bistro and Kitty's Bar and Restaurant cater to all preferences from exquisite sit-down dinners to cocktail and theatre style workshops. The unique outdoor courtyard provides a beautiful space for pre or post event gatherings. The state-of-the-art undercover bowling green provide relaxation and leisure options.

BERRAMBOOL SPORTING COMPLEX (MERIMBULA)

Just 500-metres from the centre of Merimbula, this much-loved community sporting facility plays host to cricket, Australian rules football and soccer as well as travelling circuses. Located around the main ovals are junior fields and a skatepark providing ample space for event activation. With the tree-lined Merimbula Creek flowing around the boundary of the site, it is another of our region's many venues that nestles in the natural surroundings the Sapphire Coast is known for.

FORD PARK MULTI-USE COURTS (MERIMBULA)

A stone's throw away from the stunning Merimbula Main Beach, Ford Park's undercover courts play host to basketball and netball games all year long. The facility has hosted 3-on-3 basketball tournaments with success. With the grass expanse of Ford Park immediately adjacent to the courts, the precinct is ideal for events that incorporate activities that extend beyond basketball and netball.

BEGA SPORTING COMPLEX

Located just metres from the centre of Bega, the Bega Sporting Complex is one of our region's best utilised and beloved event venues. In recent years it has played host to major events including a Monster Truck meet, NRL pre-season and trial matches and major live music performances. Situated next to Bega Primary School's ovals, the Keith Mitchell Playing Fields next to the Bega River, and only a few hundred metres from the Roy Howard Oval, it is ideally suited for large-scale events that require large spill-over areas for parking.

With plans well-advanced for an upgrade to the venue's facilities (scheduled completion 2025), the Bega Sporting Complex is an ideal venue for major concerts, special events and sporting events.

DICKINSON OVAL (BERMAGUI)

Located between the Bermagui town centre and the famous Bermagui Fishermen's Wharf, Dickinson Oval is beautifully situated and only a stone's throw from the main beach. Adjacent to the Bermagui Surf Club (a regularly used event venue in itself) and opposite the Bermagui Country Club, the venue is surrounded by well-appointed facilities that have capacity to host large groups and in turn serve as a social hub for any events hosted on the oval.

A much-loved community facility, it regularly hosts major events including the famous annual Bermagui Dog Show each February. In recent years it has also played host to the Bermagui Seaside Fair, the Greater Western Sydney Giants Development Academy trial night and the opening concert of the Four Winds Festival.

A versatile space that can host events ranging from classic music performances to elite sports team trials, Dickinson Oval is an ideal venue for a wide variety of events.

COBARGO SHOWGROUND

The picturesque Cobargo Showground has been operating for nearly 140 years. As a dedicated showground, it serves not only as a major event venue but also as an integral part of the local agricultural economy. The Cobargo Showground provides agistment for stock, corrals, a cattle yard, an equestrian arena, dog events and dressage rings.

With camping facilities and amenities blocks, it can accommodate event attendees on-site during major events. Across the site are a range of different venue spaces and facilities. A large pavilion, function room, canteen, bar and three open-sided sheds are all situated on the central hill, with a range of smaller spaces and facilities scattered around the larger site.

Home to the Cobargo Folk Festival and Cobargo Show, the Cobargo Showground is a treasured community asset that is proudly and distinctively rural. Three-phase power available

TURA BEACH COUNTRY CLUB

So much more than great views. Tura Beach is a true championship golf course with two of the best bowling greens in the region, tennis facilities, function rooms that offer spectacular ocean views, a fabulous new bistro and so much more.

Designed by five-time British Open winner Peter Thomson and Mike Woolveridge, the course weaves through mature eucalyptus forest with undulating and challenging terrain. The layout offers spectacular views from tees and greens over the Pacific Ocean and every hole provide unique challenges for players of all levels.

Having hosted Pro Am's, including the Bega Cheese Pro Am and NSW/ACT PGA Associates events, Tura Beach Country Club is the ideal location for your next golfing odyssey.


EDEN GOLF COURSE

Located just 15 minutes south of Merimbula Airport, this John Spencer designed course is a hidden gem of the Sapphire Coast. GRAVITY EDEN MOUNTAIN **BIKE PARK**

Gravity Eden Mountain Bike Park is a new mountain biking destination located in Nullica State Forest in Eden. The park encompasses 58-kilometres of premium machine-built singletrack featuring trails for all skill levels with an emphasis on gravity and flow riding.

The primary trailhead is located only minutes from Eden and features a dirt jump park, asphalt pump track with solar lighting, car parking and toilets. Gravity Eden has already played host to 'The Orca' Quad Crown MTB Series stage racing event to positive acclaim.


