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### 1 Introduction

### 1.1 Scope

This policy applies to all public land, road or building assets owned or controlled by Bega Valley Shire Council.

The scope of this policy demonstrates direct commitment to the following strategic guiding principles:

- Equitable and inclusive | commitment to building connection with stakeholders and build trust and respect with the community.
- Transparent | open in decision-making process and updating of progress.
- Financially sustainable | generating greater revenue and reducing reliance on rates for income.
- Accountable | proactive consultation and engagement.

# 1.2 Purpose

To ensure that public land is maintained and used safely for the amenity and benefit of the resident community, visitors and the environment.

# 3 Implementation

# 3.1 Policy Statement

Bega Valley Shire Council will address the matter of 'Lands under Council jurisdiction' in a systematic manner by:

- To pProvidinge a policy framework through which Bega Valley Shire Council can consider its freehold and vested reserve land, buildings, and roads, and make decisions, using a systematic, informed approach with respect to the management, retention, disposal, dedication, or acquisition of such assets
- To eEnsuringe that decisions made in relation to regarding the use of Bega Valley Shire Council's land and building assets guarantee maximum return to the Shire, by either by achieving realising a commercial level of financial return or by fulfilling a community benefit aligned withto the Bega Valley Community Strategic Plan
- To create Generating greater revenue from current and potential land, property and facility building, and road holdings, thereby to reducing reliance on rates for income
- Implementing guidelines that document the range of activities or uses that are subject to an approval or consent of BVSCby Council
- Obtaining appropriate rentals for the use of public land, building and road holdings
- Applying the principles of consistency, transparency, and accountability to the procedures relateding to this
  Policy, in order to ensuringe appropriate use and management of Council controlled and buildings
- Ensuring that Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) requirements are adhered to for persons wishing to land private helicopters on lands under Council's jurisdiction.
